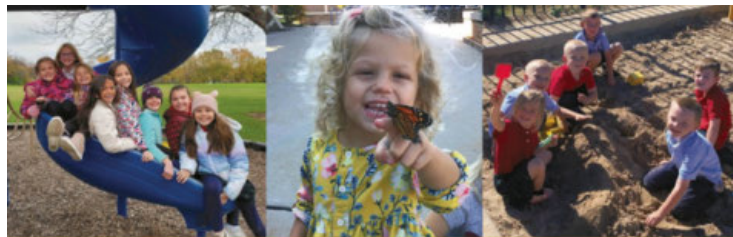
## SMV IS LOOKING FOR A DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

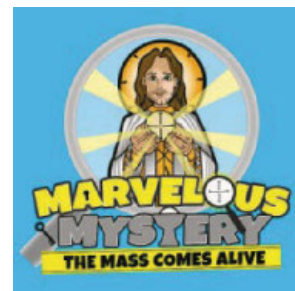
