

St. Mary's Visitation Parish Privacy Policy

Updated: March 1, 2018

Welcome to the website (the "Website") of St. Mary's Visitation Parish. This Privacy Policy (the "Policy") states the Parish's policy relative to the information, including personal data and other information, collected from visitors to this Website.

Information Collected

When you visit St. Mary's Visitation Parish using this Website, we may collect personal data from you. The data collected includes the following:

Personal Information. St. Mary's Visitation Parish only collects personally identifiable information on a voluntary basis. This information is provided to St. Mary's by the visitor through the completion and submission of forms, inquiries, and other similar means. "Personal Information" may include, but is not limited to, a visitor's name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address. By voluntarily providing St. Mary's Visitation with Personal Information, the provision of such information indicates the visitor's consent to St. Mary's Visitation's use of the Personal Information in accordance with this Policy.

Non-Personal Information. When you interact with St. Mary's Visitation via this Website, St. Mary's Visitation receives and stores certain personally non-identifiable information ("Non-Personal Information"). Non-Personal Information, which is passively collected using various technologies, cannot be used to identify a specific user. St. Mary's Visitation may store such information itself or in databases owned and maintained by Archdiocesan affiliates, agents, or service providers. St. Mary's Visitation may aggregate personally non-identifiable information.

Cookies. In connection with the operation of this Website, St. Mary's Visitation may employ the use of technology commonly known as "cookies." A "cookie" is an element of data that a website can send to the Internet browser of a visitor to that website. A "cookie" is not a computer program and has no ability to read data residing on the visitor's computer or instruct it to perform any step or function. The "cookie" does not extract any Personal Information.

Use of Information Collected

St. Mary's Visitation uses Personal Information a visitor provides in a manner consistent with this Policy. If a visitor provides Personal Information for a specific reason, St. Mary's Visitation will use the Personal Information for the purpose it was provided. St. Mary's Visitation, its subsidiaries, affiliates, and agents may use Personal Information and Non-Personal Information collected through the Website to improve the content and functionality of the Website.

St. Mary's Visitation may disclose Personal Information if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to (i) comply with a legal obligation, (ii) protect or defend the rights or property of St. Mary's Visitation, (iii) act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of visitors to the Website, or (iv) protect against legal liability.

Disclosure of Information Collected

St. Mary's Visitation will not sell, license, transmit, or disclose information collected to parties unaffiliated with St. Mary's Visitation unless such sale, license, transmittal, or disclosure is expressly authorized by the visitor or required or permitted by law. In all cases, St. Mary's Visitation will disclose information collected consistent with applicable laws and regulations, and will require the recipient of such information to protect the information and use it only for the purpose it was provided.

Exclusions

This Privacy Policy does not apply to any Personal Information collected by St. Mary's Visitation other than Personal Information collected through this Website. St. Mary's Visitation shall be free to reproduce, use, disclose, and distribute any unsolicited information to others without limitation or attribution. This includes, but is not limited to, information posted to any public areas of the Website, such as bulletin boards, any ideas for new information, resources, products or services, and other unsolicited submissions.

Use by Children

St. Mary's Visitation does not knowingly collect Personal Information from children under the age of 13. If you are under the age of 13, please do not submit any Personal Information through this Website. If there is reason to believe that a child under the age of 13 has provided Personal Information through this Website, please contact St. Mary's Visitation.

Security

St. Mary's Visitation takes reasonable precautions to protect visitors to its Website and information provided by such visitors. Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Any transmission of personal information is at your own risk. St. Mary's Visitation is not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures contained on the Website.
