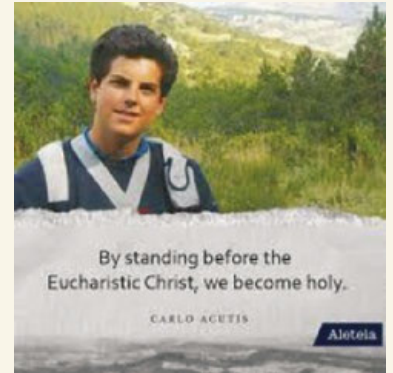
JOIN US FOR MAY CROWNING MAY 16TH

BAPTISM PREPARATION

Once the time has been set, the family will meet with the priest, at which time they will be given the necessary materials to help them plan the funeral liturgy. 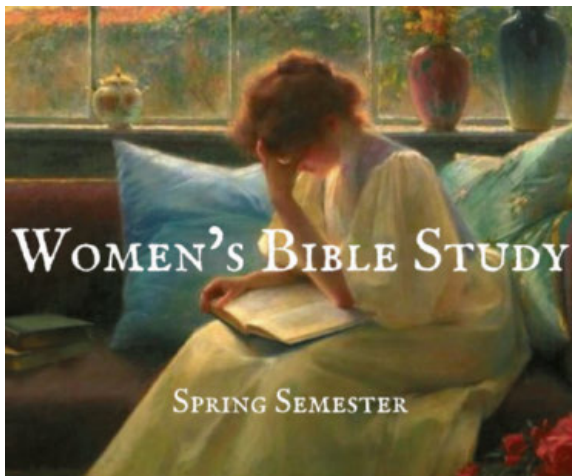

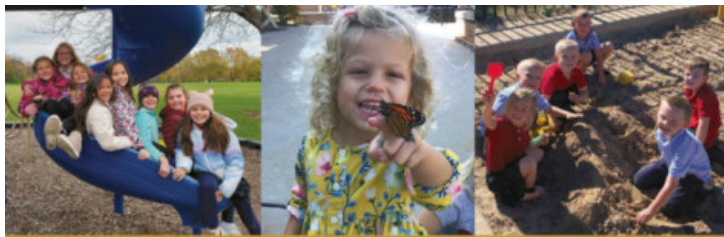

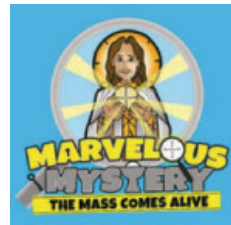
