### BAPTISM PREPARATION

*Children ages 6 and under:* Those seeking to have children baptized should be registered, active members of St. Mary's Visitation Parish. Parents are expected to complete a preparation class, preferably before the birth of the child. The class is offered bi-monthly, upcoming classes include:

Once the time has been set, the family will meet with the priest, at which time they will be given the necessary materials to help them plan the funeral liturgy. 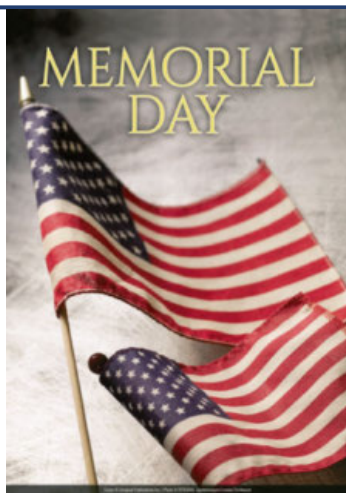
## GUIDE BOOK & DIRECTORY ADVERTISING
