The Corpus Christi procession is a centuries-old tradition of the Catholic faith to carry the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist in a public procession.



ADORATION CHAPEL

“Prayer is like swimming: instructions and suggestions help, but you must do it yourself, not just talk about it.” The more you pray, the better you become. Jesus Himself said, *“Come to me all you who labor and are burdened and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy and my burden light.”* Make time to visit Jesus in the St. Mary’s Perpetual Adoration Chapel. Share your cares and joys with Him, and thank Him for his daily help. BAPTISM PREPARATION

MINISTRY OF THE MONTH



St. Mary's Perpetual Adoration Chapel has been open for prayer 24 hours a day, seven days a week since October 7, 1985. The Chapel began in what is now the Usher's Room in the rear vestibule of church and later moved to its current location, which is the former church baptistery.

There must be at least one person in the Adoration Chapel at all times. The ideal situation is to have two signed up for each hour. A schedule of these regular volunteers covers each of the 168-one hour shifts each week, and a volunteer coordinator is in charge of overseeing each day of the week. At the present time the majority of hours have only one person scheduled. You decide what hour is best for you and notify one of the coordinators or the Parish Office. You may sign up to do an hour weekly, bi-weekly or monthly. A list of hours for which we urgently need coverage is published in the weekly bulletin. Those who are unable to commit to a regular hour can sign up as a substitute, to be called upon when the need arises. You may notify the Parish Office or one of the coordinators concerning what days and hours you would be available if needed.

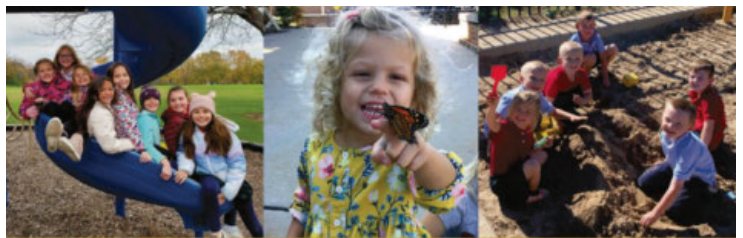
